

History Bus

A free History Bus service will run on the first Sunday of every month beginning on May 2nd and continuing until 3rd October.

It will call at Aston Hall, Aston Manor Transport Museum, Soho House, the Pen Room, Sarehole Mill and Blakesley Hall. There is a small charge for admission to the Aston Manor Transport Museum, all other museums do not have entrance fees. Hop on and off to visit the museums you want to see without having to worry about taking the car or paying for the bus! The History Bus will start from Birmingham Museum and Art Gallery at 11.30am and then at every hour until 3.30pm.

The bus will run on 2nd May, 6th June, 4th July, 1st August, 5th September and 3rd October.
