

THE BROMSGROVE LOWNE OF 1723

Bromsgrove is extremely fortunate to have a wealth of historical documents relating to the governance and organisation of St John's Parish over several centuries. Many have survived and in the middle of the last century the documents, including the parish registers, were deposited at the Worcestershire County Record Office (now Worcestershire Archives) by the then Incumbent, the Revd Dr F.G. Shepherd. The documents are held under the reference 850/9135. The Lowne of 1723 is the first entry in 'The Church Wardens Book 1723' (850/9135/17/1). Lownes (or Lewnes) were used to raise money for the parish by taxing property/land owners. The money was paid by the owner or very often by a tenant, the amount of the payment relating to the supposed value of the land and/or property. A good proportion of the money raised no doubt was spent in poor relief.

The parish is split into 'yields', of which there are ten starting with the Town Yield (itself split in two parts). A description of these yields, including a map, is found in the booklet 'Bromsgrove and the Poll Tax of 1690' produced by the Bromsgrove Branch of the Birmingham & Midland Society for Genealogy and Heraldry under ISBN 1 870331 680. The amounts of money yielded from the parishioners were divided into shillings, pence and quarters of a penny, with the symbolism for the latter in the third column in the original document consisting of 'ob' for a halfpenny and 'q' (with a stroke across its tail) for a quarter penny or farthing. These symbols are derived from obulus, an ancient grecian coin, and quadrans an ancient roman coin. It is unusual perhaps to find the use of these symbols as late as in the 1720's.

This document will be of interest to both historians and genealogists. The entries for the Town Yield may be in linear order and could be compared with other lownes. Individual owners and properties may be found in the wealth of Bromsgrove deeds, wills and other such records. To the genealogist the data may be useful. For my own research the lowne shows my ancestor William Nock renting land from the Earl of Plymouth in the Fockbury Yield for a total of 1½d and in the Burcot Yield he was renting land/property from Martin Blick for 7¾d, Nicholas Hill 1½d and Taylor ½d. Other sources show:- William Nock as a witness to a codicil to Martin Blick's will, Martin being a prosperous Quaker who died in January 1725/6; William Nock had married a Quaker girl; William's wife and children were in receipt of outdoor poor law relief in 1728 when living in the Burcot yield. The lowne shows William Nock to be a husbandman (tenant farmer).

These Bromsgrove records are a marvellous source of data for us all to research; however a proportion of those records are in such poor condition that they cannot be used, with some so fragile that they would fall to bits when using them. These documents need professional conservation which costs money. The Church of the Parish of St John the Baptist cannot be expected to raise the required money; the Church has more pressing needs. Perhaps others may organise themselves to raise money to save these documents for posterity?
